# FLOO CHECKLIST











#### **Before a flood**

- Ask your local council if your area floods
- Check your insurance policy is current and covers you for flood
- Check if you need sandbags
- Know where to go for safety and safe routes to get there
- Talk to your family and make an emergency plan
- Put together an emergency kit
- Prepare a list of emergency contact numbers and keep them in or near your phone

## When a warning is issued:

- Activate your emergency plan
- Locate your emergency kit
- Check on your neighbours
- Make sure your mobile phone is fully charged
- Check local and social media for information, updates, and advice
- Sandbag your toilet, drains and around doors and vents outside
- Put household objects above the expected water level

### **During a flood**

- Check local and social media for information, updates and advice
- Monitor road closure information visit police.sa.gov.au
- Keep in contact with your neighbours
- Follow the advice of emergency services
- Do not allow children to play in or near floodwaters

#### **Returning after** a flood

- Check local and social media for information, updates and advice
- Turn off the electricity and gas before you go inside
- Use a torch to inspect your buildings for damage
- Don't use gas or electricity until they have been checked for safety
